

RULES SUMMARY

Authors are responsible for reading the full rules
and FAQ available online at www.gppl.ca
and the Children’s Information Desk at GPPL.

1. Authors must live in the City or County of Grande Prairie, or the MD of Greenview.
2. Entries must be unpublished, 2000 words or fewer, and the work of a single author.
3. Entries must be typed in a minimum 12-point font and double-spaced.
4. The author must staple a complete entry form to the front of the entry with the author’s contact information.
5. The author’s name must not appear anywhere else in the entry.
6. Entries must be submitted in print form; e-mailed entries will not be accepted.
7. Each author must save a copy of their story (as .doc, .docx, .odt, or .rtf) to submit if they are selected as a winner.
8. **It is the responsibility of authors to ensure their stories are submitted in compliance with these rules.**
9. GPPL staff members are not responsible for catching errors when entries are submitted.
